


CASE STUDY-1 (SIDDHARTH NAGAR)

ZONING PLAN





GROUND FLOOR FUNCTIONS SECOND FLOOR PLAN



ARE DESINED TO KEEP IN MIND SUCH THAT DESIGN WILL NOT COST FOR ANY LOSS OF LIFE AND MONEY. FORM FOLLOWS FUNCTION IS THE WAY TO DESIGN THE HOSPITAL CAREFULLY ACCORDING TO ITS REQUIRMENTS . THE AYURVEDC HOSPITAL BLOCK WILL HAVE THE DESIGN ACCORDING TO FORM FOLLOWS FUNCTION AND HAVING A COURTYARD AT THE MIDDLE OF THE BUILDING BLOCK, THE BUILDING WILL BE GIVEN ENTRY / EXIT FROM FOUR SIDE WHICH ARE EAST, WEST, NORTH AND SOUTH. THE HOSPITAL BUILDING WILL HAVE RECEPTION / WAITING AT THE SOUTH SIDE, O.P.D. BLOCK AT THE EAST SIDE, EMERGENCY AT THE NORTH SIDE AND DOCTOR'S AREA PLASTER ROOM AT THE WEST SIDE OF THE BUILDING. AT THE FIRST FLOOR WE HAVE



DESIGN FOR GOOD VENTILATION, NATURAL LIGHT AND EASY ACCESSBILITY

THE HOSPITAL IS DESIGNED SUITABLE TO ALL THE CLIMATE CONDITIONS WETHER IT IS WINTER OR IT IS SUMMER BECAUSE A SIDE OF THE BUILDING RECEIVES SUNLIGHT FOR A LIMITED TIME OF THE DAY . ALSO THE ENTRY AND EXIT OF THE BUILDING IS KEPT SUCH THAT FROM THE FRONT SIDE WE CAN GET TWO ENTRY / EXIT AND IF WE GO TO LITTLE BACK SIDE OF THE BUILDING FROM NORTH AND SOUTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING WE GET ANOTHER TWO ENTRY / EXIT OF THE BUILDING . SO WE DON'T REALLY HAVE TO GO AT THE FARTHEST MOST POINT OF THE BUILDING TO EXCESS IT.






VERTICAL STACKING




INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK

IN THE INSTITUTE FOR AYURVEDIC MEDICAL COLLEGE, EDUCATION RELATED TO AYURVEDIC MEDICAL SCIENCE IS GIVEN TO STUDENTS .IN INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK CONSITS OF SPACES AND AREAS DEDICATED TO ADMINISTRATION, OFFICES, CANTEEN, MESS, LECTURE ROOMS, LIBRARY, LABORATORIES, SEMINAR HALLS, THEATERS AND MEETING ROOMS ETC. THE FUNCTIONALITY OF THE BUILDING IS VERY IMPORTANT IN THE INSTITUTIONAL BUILDING SO WE DESIGN THE INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK BY KEEPING IN MIND THE PHYLOSOPHYOF ARHITECT LOUIS SULLIVAN WHICH IS "FORM FOLLOWS FUNCTION ". THE BUILDING COMPLEX OF THE INSTITUTION WILL BE DESIGNED SUCH THAT IT WILL HAVE ADMINISTRATION BLOCK, INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK, AND FOOD BLOCK SEPARATELY. THE ADMINISTRATION AND FOOD BLOCK ARE BOTH CONNECTED TO INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK BY BRIDGES.




SEP BY STEP EVOLUTION OF FORM

THE INSTITUTIONAL BUILDING IS ORIE TO THE NORTH – SOUTH DIRECTION S THERE WILL BE LESS EFFECT OF SUNLI **RADIATION ON THE BUILDING BLOCK** NORTH – SOUTH BUIDING ORIENTATIC IS CONSIDERED BEST ORIENTATION O A BUILDING IN INDIA .



FUNCTIONING, WILL BE KEPT SEPERATELY SO THAT TO AVOID THE DIFFERENT KINDS OF WORK GOING AT A SAME PLACE BECAUSE DIFFERENT KINDS OF WORKING AT A SAME PLACE MAY CREATE DISTURBANCE TO OTHER PEOPLES AT THE SAME PLACE. ORIENTATION, LIGHT AND VENTILATION


THE INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK WILL BE DESIGNED BY KEEPING IN MIND THE FUNCTION, COMFORT IN ENTERING AN AREA OR SPACE OF THE BUILDING . FOR PROPER VENTILATION AND ACCESIBILITY OF NATURAL LIGHT IN THE BUILDING COMPLEX OF INSTITUTION IS DIVIDED IN THREE SEPARATE BLOCKS I.E. ADMINISTRATION BLOCK, INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK, AND FOOD BLOCK SEPARATELY. THE ADMINISTRATION AND FOOD BLOCK ARE BOTH CONNECTED TO INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK BY BRIDGES. THE ORIENTATION OF THE ENTIRE BUILDING COMPLEX NORTH / SOUTH WHICH IS GOOD IN SUMMER AS WELL AS WINTER.

THE CONCEPT IN THE INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK IS TO KEEP SEPARATE BLOCKS FOR DIFFERENT AREA OF USE . THIS HELPS THE BUILDING TO VENTILATE PROPERLY AND ADEQUATE AMOUNT OF NATURAL LIGHT INTERING IN THE BUILDING . THE SEPARATE BLOCKS FOR DIFFERENT PURPOSE OF USE ALSO LEADS TO LESS DISTURBANCE IN THE BUILDING AS, DIFFERENT KINDS OF WORK GOING ON IN SEPARATED AREAS.

FLOORSOF THE INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK IS ALIGNED ABOVE EACHOTHER . ALL THE FLOORS ARE SHOWN IN DIFFERENT COLOURS. AT THE DIFFERENT FLOORS SOME OF THE AREAS IN THE TERM OF FUNCTIONING CHANGES.

RESIDENTIAL AREA


THE RESIDENTIAL AREA IS THE AREA OF THE INTIRE BUILDING COMPLEX OF THE AYURVEDIC MEDICAL COLLEGEIN WHICH THE STUDENTS, FACULTIES, DOCTORS AND WORKERS LIVE. THE HOSTELS AND APARTMENTS ARE DESIGNED SUCH THAT PEOPLE CAN FEEL FULL COMFORT AND THERE WILL BE PROPER CIRCULATION IN THE BUILDING, THERE WILL BE GOOD VENTILATION IN THE BUILDING AND THERE WILL BE ACCESS AWAILABILITY OF NATURAL LIGHT IN THE BUILDING.







ZONING

ZONING IS THE PROCESS OF DIVIDING LAND IN ZONES (E.G. RESIDENTIAL, INDUSTRIAL) IN WHICH THERE IS A REASON BEHIND THE PLACEMENT OF BLOCKS IN THE SITE PROPOSED FOR THE CERTAIN LAND USES ARE PERMITTED OR PROHIBITED . IN ADDITION, THE SIZES, BULK, AND CONSTRUCTION OF AYURVEDIC MEDICAL COLLEGE . THE MOST PRIORITY IS GIVEN TO THE PLACEMENT OF BUILDINGS MAY BE REGULATED. FUNCTIONALITY OF THE AYURVEDIC HOSPITAL, THERE IS ONE ACCESS TO THE SITE FROM THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF ZONING IS TO SEGREGATE USES THAT ARE THOUGHT TO BE THE SOUTH-EAST DIRECTION OF THE SITE, SO THE AYURVEDIC HOSPITAL BLOCK IS PLACED INCOMPATIBLE. IN PRACTICE, ZONING ALSO IS USED TO PREVENT NEW DEVELOPMENT FROM AT THE SOUTH – EASTERN MOST CORNER OF THE SITE SUCH THAT PEOPLE CAN ACCESS **INTERFERING WITH EXISTING USES**. THE AYURVEDIC HOSPITAL FIRSTLY BY ENTERING THE FIRST ENTRY OF THE SITE . THE INSTITUTIONAL BLOCK IS KEPT AT THE MIDDLE OF THE SITE WHICH IS ACCESSIBLE BY MIDDLE ENTRY OF THE SITE . THE HOSTEL BLOCK IS PLACED AT THE NORTH MOST SIDE OF THE SITE AND IS ACCESIBLE BY THE BIDDLE ENTRY OR THE NORTH MOST ENTRY OF THE SITE. THE RESIDENTIAL BLOCKS AND APARTMENT ARE PLACE AT THE WEST OF THE SITE, RESIDENTIAL AREA IS AT FARTHEST IN THE WEST AND SEPARATED FROM OTHER AREA IS SILENT AND CALMEST PLACE WHERE PEOPLE WILL LIVE IN PEACE. THE PARKING IS GIVEN ON THE FRONT SIDE OF THE SITE BETWEEN THE SOUTH – EAST ENTRY AND SITE'S MIDDLE ENTRY.




ZONING OF AYURVEDIC MEDICAL COLLEGE, VARANASI SITE




WIND DIRECTION

Landscape architecture is the design of outdoor areas, landmarks, and structures to achieve environmental, socialbehavioural, or aesthetic outcomes. Landscape architects analyze, plan, design, manage, and nurture the built and the natural environments. It may be defined as 'the art of composing landform, water, vegetation, buildings, paving and climate to make good outdoor space'.


Look beyond plants

Create visual lines

A line can be any "skinny" element that wanders through the garden. Common lines in landscape design ideas include paths, fences, edgings, or a wall. In general, curved lines are more interesting than straight ones in landscape design. Use to entice visitors to a special place (like a shady nook) or to draw their eyes to a special element
